

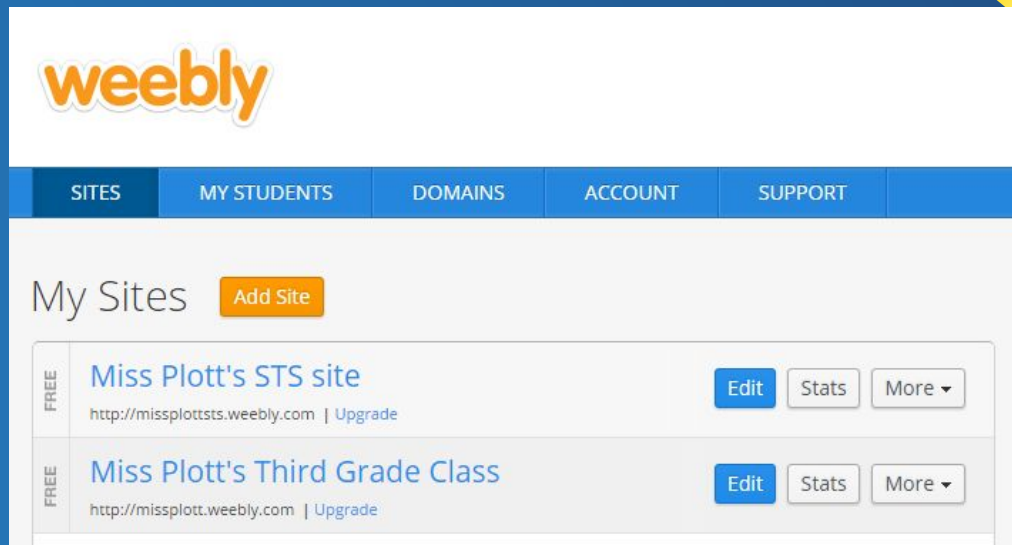

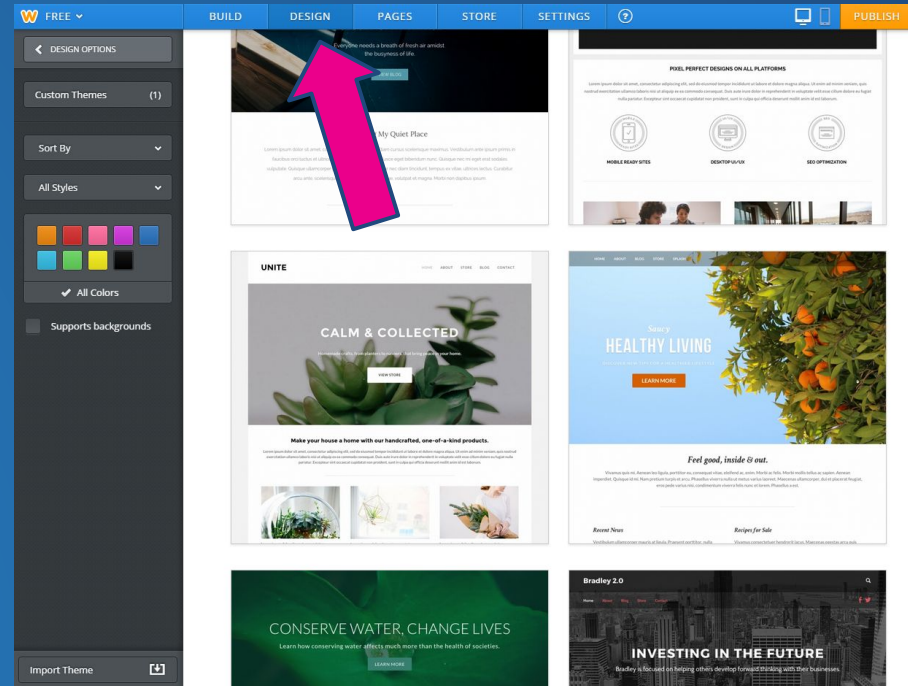
# Getting Started

4. Don't be afraid!



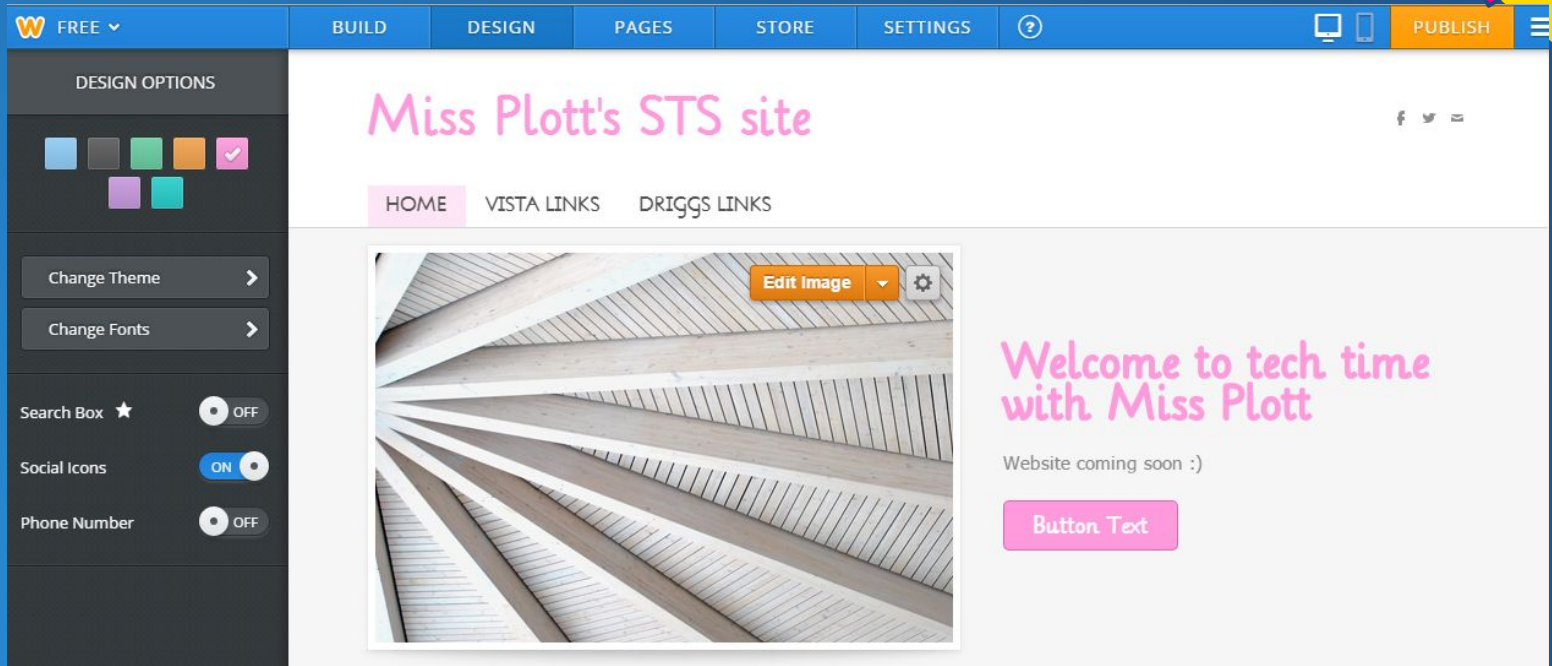
# Choosing a layout (“Theme”)

Layouts / themes are located in the “design” menu. Weebly will prompt you to pick one when you sign up, but you can change it at any time.



# How to save

“Publish” is the save button. Anytime you make a change, you want to “publish” it.



# Publishing

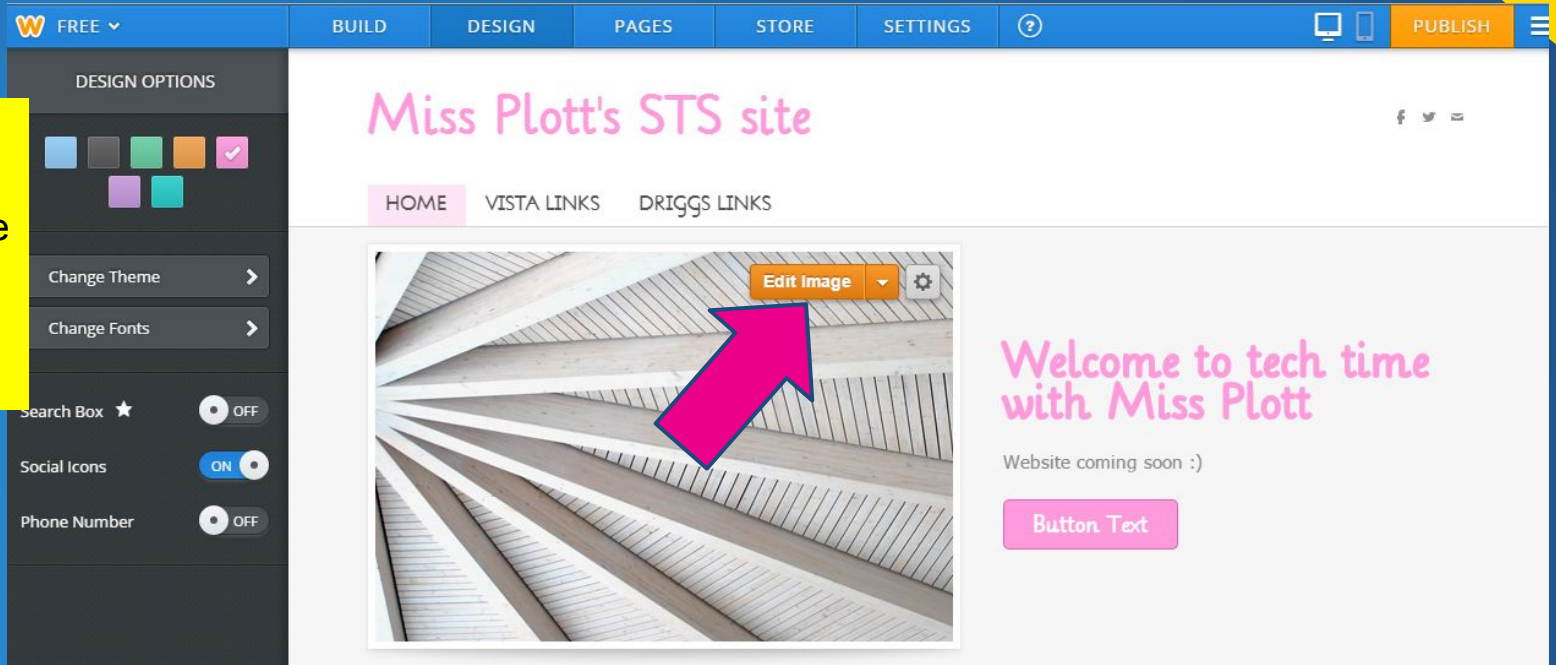
When you hit publish, you will see this screen - this lets you know that you have successfully saved your changes. Teachers do NOT need to buy the domain, but it will prompt them every time.

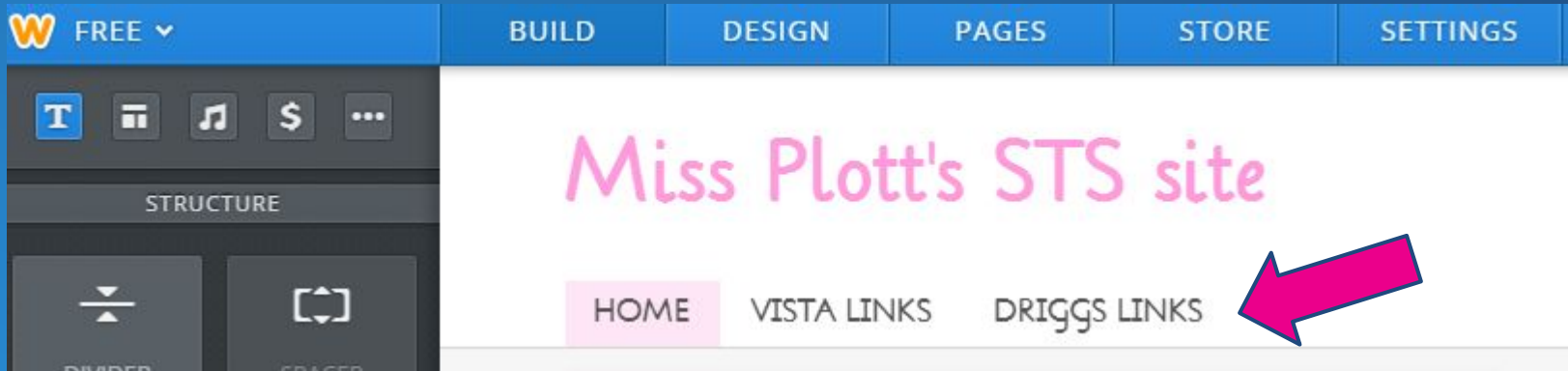
# Adding Elements (“Build”)

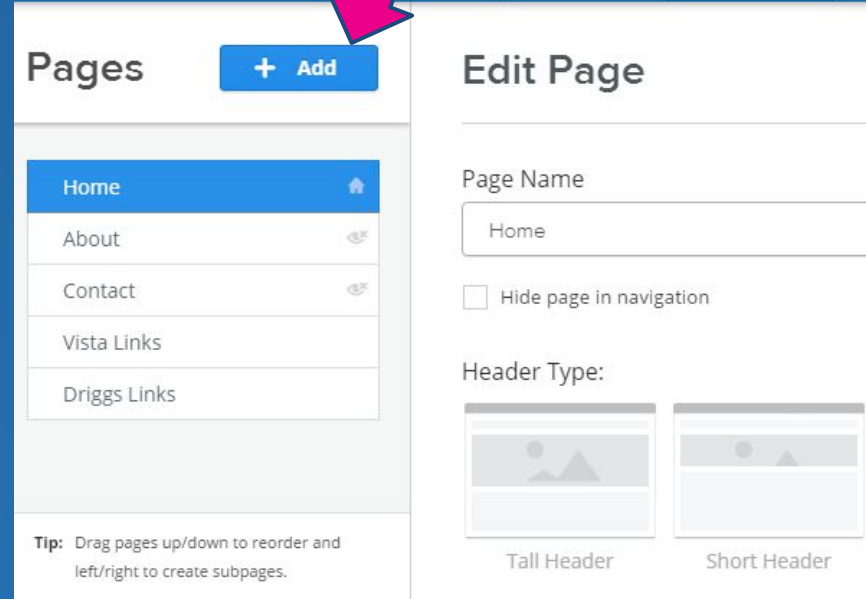

You create additional pages here. You can decide if they are “main” pages (links displayed on the home page) or if they are smaller pages you link to within your site.



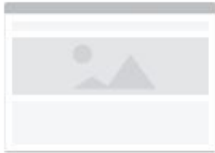

Landing Page

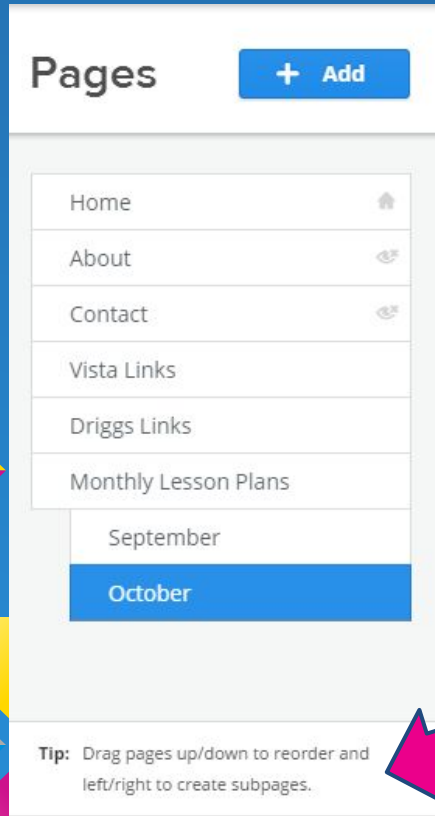
When making a new page, give it a name; decide if you want it showing or hidden in the main navigation; choose a header type; then press “save and edit”
